Elks Camp Barrett (ECB) is a camp designed to help young people develop and grow by affording the opportunity of getting outdoors for adventure and fun. It is operated by the Elks Association of Maryland, Delaware and the District of Columbia. The Camp is located at 1001 Chesterfield Road, Annapolis, MD.

Some of the traditional summer camp activities include: swimming, archery, nature study, arts and crafts, hiking, a carefully supervised marksmanship range (pellets), and zip line. Special programming is updated each season and has included computer building, kitchen science, woodworking, herb gardening, forestry, financial literacy, drama, games, robotics, and various team sports.
